Terms of the call for tenders

1.1. Preamble

Hatches Ltd in partnership with Ento Feeds ltd and Agricultural Business Initiative (aBi), is implementing a project titled "Increasing Market Access and Productivity of the Poultry Value Chain through Effective and Environmentally Efficient Inputs in Central and Eastern Uganda".

The project objectives are:

- Provision of high-quality Day-old chicks to both model farmers and open market poultry farmers;
- ii. Promote the use of Black Soldier Flies (BSF) as an alternative to traditional protein sources for quality poultry feeds at fair and stable prices;
- iii. Establish sustainable market linkage options for farmers with off takers; and to
- iv. Enhance farmer knowledge on modern poultry farming through training and demonstration.



1.2. Candidates

Any legally established entity and whose qualifications and experience enable it to meet the requirements imposed by this call can take part in this call for tenders. It will be up to the bidders to provide proof of their qualifications and experience for this type of contract.

It is understood that participation in this competition implies acceptance of the clauses contained in this document. The following candidates shall be excluded from participation and award of contracts if:

- Those who are bankrupt, in liquidation, in legal proceedings, cessation of activity or other similar situations according to the national law and regulation,
- Those who have been convicted from a judging authority for an offense affecting their professional integrity,
- Those who have committed a serious professional misconduct,
- Those who have not completed their duties related to payment of social welfare contributions or taxes in their country or in the one where the contract must occur.
- Those who were sentenced for corruption, fraud, or who participated in a criminal organization or any other illicit activities,
- Those under administrative sanctions,
- Those who are in conflict of interest for the contract involved,
- Those having made false statements or that having concealed information for the contract involved. The candidates must certify that they do not fall in any of the above categories.

1.3. Call for Tender Process

1.3.1. Submission of tenders

Bidders must respect the date indicated on page 1 ("Deadline for receipt of tenders"). Any tender received afterwards shall be rejected.

1.3.2. Modification of the call for tenders

Hatches Itd may at any time before the deadline for submission of tenders, for reasons of its own or as a result of requests for clarification from the candidates, amend the call for tender documents. This amendment shall be notified in writing to all bidders and on the media used to publish the call and will be binding on all applicants. In order to allow candidates to take these changes into account, the date for submission of tenders may be delayed.



1.3.3. Modification or withdrawal of tenders

Bidders may withdraw or amend their offer at any time BEFORE the deadline for submission of tenders. Bidders shall remain bound by their tenders for a period of 100 days from the deadline for submission of tenders.

1.3.4. Opening of tenders

Opening of tenders may be on the June 30th, 2022 at 10 a.m (unless changed by Hatches) at Hatches Itd Office, Akamwesi Complex, Level 2, Room No. A10, Nakawa, Kampala/Uganda. All tenders received (including amendments submitted within set deadline) shall be opened by Hatches Itd evaluation committee. Only technical proposals will be opened. A member of the selection committee will read aloud, offer after, the following information:

- The identity of the bidder
- The number and status of the envelopes received
- The documents in the envelopes
- Possible modifications or withdrawals
- Possible declarations made by the bidder.

This information will be included in the minutes of the opening of tenders. The committee will then proceed to review and analyse the technical offers.

1.3.5. Request for clarification

Hatches Itd may request clarification from bidders after bid opening. This request cannot in any way modify an offer.

1.3.6. Evaluation of tenders

The procedure for evaluating tenders will be as follows:

- Examination of the conformity of the proposal with the requirements in the call for tenders. Tenders deemed to be non-compliant at the end of this examination will be rejected;
- Evaluation of the technical quality of the tender, on the basis of the criteria described below,
- Scoring and classification of tenders evaluated in accordance with the criteria described below,
- Opening of the envelopes labelled "Financial Proposal/Offer" only for tenders which have at least obtained the minimum technical score required (see below § Criteria for evaluating technical offers). The evaluation of the financial quality will be based on the criteria described below:



- Comparison and classification of tenders according to the scores awarded
- Award of the contract provided that the amount of the tender falls within the financial resources provided for by Hatches Itd.

1.3.7. Criteria for Evaluating Technical offers

- Score 10, Specification of delivery terms as Plot 11/12 Block 187 Kyagwe Mbalala Mukono, Uganda, East Africa
- Score 30, Suppliers with local office in Uganda and ready to offer installation, commissioning and after works services (if any needed).
- Score 30, Clarity in product description in detail and guarantee
- Score 20, Evidence of Similar products delivery and appropriate production facilities
- Score 10, Specify quotation validity and delivery times

Thus, a total of 100 score for the technical proposal. Only candidates with a technical score of 60 or more will be selected for financial offers/proposals evaluation

1.3.8. Evaluating of Financial Offers

These tenders which have been prequalified for the evaluation of their technical offers will be the subject of a verification of the financial offer by Hatches ltd to rectify any calculation errors (the amount in words prevailing on the amount in figures) or for any request for clarification.

Tenders will be checked for completeness of the bids and confirming that all items were priced. The following will be applied:

- i. correction of arithmetic errors
- ii. application of unconditional discounts offered

1.3.9. Comparison and ranking of offers

The comparison of offers will be made on the basis of the ranking obtained from the overall score assigned to each bid, which is the sum of the technical score and the financial score. The maximum total is therefore 100 points (one hundred fifty points).

1.3.10. Notification of the result

Before the expiry of the period of validity of the tenders, Hatches Itd will notify the selected bidder in writing that his tender has been accepted and will send him a draft contract.



2. Terms of the contract

Bidders are invited to comply with all the procedures described below. Bids that do not meet the required terms and forms will be automatically rejected.

2.2. Language

The offer shall be in Uganda Shillings, any VAT and other taxes must be specified.

2.4. Guarantees

The bidder shall indicate in his offer the guarantee period and the damages covered.

3. Instructions to bidders

3.1. Submission of tenders:

The tender documents shall be submitted in sealed (ZIP) envelope, in one original copy marked as such.

3.2. Content of the offer

3.2.1. Technical offer

The bidder shall complete and provide the letter of submission attached to this document. The tender is made up of two parts:

✓ Administrative:

The bidder provides information about his company through the attached form. He is free to provide evidence and other documents he wishes to show Hatches Itd that justifies his qualification and experience in the procurement of contracts similar to those covered by this call for tenders. He shall also certify by any appropriate means that he is not in one of the exclusion situations listed in $\S1.2$ "Candidates".

The bidder shall submit the statement of integrity, eligibility and ethics completed and signed according to the attached template.



√ Technical offer

The tender must contain a detailed technical offer portraying a good understanding of the need, the offer shall indicate the name of the service provider (s), brief company history of his experience and references for previous similar work.

If prequalified, the bidder will be availed item specification to provide financial offer.

√ Financial offer

The bidder shall propose his financial offer using the price breakdown framework provided in the annex to this call for tenders. He shall include a quotation. He shall also indicate the period of validity of his offer and the terms of payment.
