The PFEW is responsible for farmer-led agribusiness groups into the Poultry value chain using the guidance from the Poultry Specialist and Assistant Poultry Specialist, to enhance productivity of market-oriented poultry farming using BSF as source of protein for animals.

The Extension Worker will ensure high quality production and observation of bio-security measures, standards of Hatches Ltd at modal farm's level, timely outputs in a cost-effective manner. He/She works in close collaboration with Assistant Poultry Specialist and communities with the purpose of providing poultry farming extension services, hands on capacity building training and follow up on poultry and BSF farmer's projects performance as well as connecting them to the market.
